

Universal Music Center is very proud and dedicated to its high quality programs, community outreach efforts, and live performance events.

In 2018 we set out to accomplish several goals. In 2019, many of those goals were achieved. Our highly accomplished instructor staff mentored students of all ages in varying music related subjects. In addition to musical instrument, vocal, and live performance instruction, students had opportunities to learn professional music business practices, sound engineering and multi-track recording, along with the art and creative process of original songwriting.

In 2019, this creative growth resulted in the production and release of our first UMC-CD. UMC-CD Vol. 1 features original music written and recorded in UMC's on-site multi-track recording facility.
